GROWING FORWARD 2

FARM STEWARDSHIP PROGRAM

FSP provides eligible Saskatchewan producers with financial assistance to implement Best Management Practices (BMP). To be eligible, applicants must have an Environmental Farm Plan endorsed with in the last 10 years., own or control a minimum of 320 acres of farmland in Saskatchewan, and earn a minimum of farm income in Saskatchewan in the year of application.

BMPS

1. LIVESTOCK SITE MANAGEMENT

BMP—Relocation of Livestock Confinement Facilities: Funding 60% of eligible costs to a max of \$50,000

BMP—Fencing to Protect Surface Water: Funding 50% of eligible costs to a max of \$10,000

BMP—Riparian Area Grazing Management & Fencing: Funding 50% of eligible costs to a max of \$5000

2. MANURE MANAGEMENT

BMP—Manure Storage Enhancements: Funding 30% of eligible costs to a max of \$50,000

BMP—Manure Application Equipment & Technologies: Funding 30% of eligible costs to a max of \$30,000

3. LAND MANAGEMENT

BMP—Natural Waterway Erosion Controls: Funding 75% of eligible costs to a max of \$50,000

BMP—Creek & Stream Crossing: Funding 50% of eligible costs to a max of \$20,000

BMP—Protecting High Risk Erodible & Saline Soils Rebate: Funding 50% of eligible costs to a max of \$5000

BMP—Shelterbelt Establishment: Funding a flat rate of \$600 per mile to a max of \$5000

BMP—Native Plant Establishment: Funding 50% of eligible costs to a max of \$10,000

BMP—Used Oil, Filter & Fluid Storage: Funding 50% of eligible costs to a max of \$3000

4. PEST MANAGEMENT

BMP—Integrated Pest Management Information

Collection & Monitoring: Funding 50% of eligible costs to a max of \$5000

5. IRRIGATION MANAGEMENT PLANNING

BMP—Irrigation Management Planning: Funding 50% of eligible costs to a max of \$2000

BMP—Irrigation Equipment Modification: Funding 30% of eligible costs to a max of \$10,000

BMP—Variable Rate Irrigation Technology: Funding 30% of eligible costs to a max of \$15,000

6. VARIABLE RATE TECHNOLOGY

BMP—Variable Rate Fertilizer Equipment: Funding 30% of eligible costs to a max of \$5000

BMP—Variable Rate Mapping: Funding 30% of eligible costs to a max of \$2000

Implementation of certain BMPs may be eligible by working through an Agri-Environmental Group Plan (AEGP). These BMPs include:

- Relocation of Livestock Confinement Facilities
- Fencing to Protect Surface Water
- Farmyard Run-off Control
- Natural Waterways Erosion Control
- Protecting High Risk Erodible Soils
- Creek & Stream Crossing
- Native Plant Establishment
- Riparian Area Grazing Management & Fencing
- Variable Rate Fertilizer Equipment
- Variable Rate Mapping
