



- 1) All tractors 6,500 kg maximum on steer axles with valid Sask. Highways steer axle permits, otherwise 5500 kg maximum.
- 2) TriDrive units are now recognized in the Province of Saskatchewan and the RM of Manitou Lake will be following their weights; Tridem Drive trucks are not allowed to tow Pony or Full Trailers when using a pintle hitch.
- 3) Maximum GVW shall not exceed the total sum of all axles for levels 0, 1, 2 and 3 shall not exceed Saskatchewan Primary Winter Weights

NOTE: Permits may be voided at any time due to weather & road conditions.
